**FABRIC RAILROADING** Upholstery fabrics are usually 34 to 60 inches wide as they come off the roll. To avoid seams at each width, the fabric may be rotated 90 degrees (railroaded) to allow the width fabric to be applied to the length of the upholstery. For example, if a sofa is 96" long and has a single seat cushion, by railroading, a seam is avoided in the middle. The pattern and the nature of the fabric will suggest the correct approach.
